Safety Guidelines For Our Reopening

Check-in Protocols

- Members and non-members will be greeted at the front door by an attendant who will check their temperature.
 - a. If temperature exceeds 100.4, the individual will not be allowed to enter.
 - b. EVERYONE that enters the building will be required to wear a mask. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided.
- 2. Members will receive a pre-packaged communion kit from the hospitality desk.
- 3. Members will have the option to accept offering envelopes from the hospitality desk.

Safety protocols while in the building

While occupying the building the following guidelines must be followed:

- 1. No more than 2 occupants in the restroom at a time.
- 2. Members will be seated by an usher every other row and separated by a designated marking.
- 3. Alter calls for prayer request(s) should be done while standing in the pew.
- 4. All baptism and confessions should maintain six feet.
- 5. Ushers will be available to collect offerings. The option to give online will remain available via PayPal, Cash App or Venmo.
- 6. Members MUST keep their mask on during the entire service except during the taking of communion.

Service Dismissal Safety Protocols

- 1. All members must exit through the front doors immediately following the dismissal prayer. (row by row)
- 2. To maintain social distancing and safety guidelines. Do not congregate in the building after service.
- 3. Members will not be allowed to re-enter after exiting the building.

Reminders

- Please arrive early to allow time for the check-in process.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building.
- Maintain six feet apart for social distancing (no hugging and shaking hands; do not congregate while in the building).
- The nursery will be closed.
- All water fountains will be disabled
- For the safety of others, any member experiencing cold or flu like symptoms MUST remain home.
- To prevent the spread of COVID-19, please follow the CDC guidelines and all the above directives.
